## Background

DFID has created the *Land: Enhancing Governance for Economic Development* (LEGEND) programme to promote improved governance of land as a fundamental and inclusive basis for economic development, and to strengthen land and property rights at scale. It is doing this by mobilising knowledge and capacity for design and delivery of new DFID country programmes, disseminating relevant and timely evidence, and funding innovative ideas on strengthening land governance and security of tenure.

The UK Land Policy Forum aims to enable joint action by like-minded stakeholders in the UK to help shape a better narrative on good land governance and land investments with shared value for all.

In the first meeting of the forum, we will bring together stakeholders to introduce LEGEND and its future direction, hear participants' views on the focus of LEGEND and collect priorities for future forum themes.
